





Studio Reopening - Phase 3

Below is the procedure to reopen the studio with precaution. I would like to ask everyone who is entering my studio for an in-person lesson to agree with **all** of the following:

In Person Lesson	Alternative
 <p>Bring all books you will need for your lesson and a writing pencil in your bag.</p>	 <p>Continue with video conferencing lessons instead of face to face (especially for higher risk students or if you or a family member are showing signs and symptoms.)</p>
 <p>Be on time. Ideally only one student is welcome to come into the studio at the scheduled lesson time. I will be finishing on time. There will be no waiting area setup. One adult will be allowed at the table (if you wish). I will be leaving 15 minutes between lessons to sanitize the studio and entrance.</p>	
 <p>Use hand sanitizer (on the wall) before entering the studio. Please use your washroom at home. If you need to use the building washroom, please let me know so I can sanitize. **Washrooms are shared by the offices in the building.</p>	
 <p>During the lesson keep socially distanced. We will be working each from our own piano. (2 metres apart)</p>	
 <p>If you or any of your family members show signs or symptoms and are feeling unwell, please consider the alternative and email to cancel your in-person lesson.</p>
